	(1) The Range is normally open 7 days a week, from sun up to sun down, except for below. No shooting before sun up or after sun down.

	(3) Club Matches, both Group and Score, will be \$5.00/yardage for club members, \$10.00/yardage for non-members

General Match Rules – 2026 Season

1. All shooters 18 years and younger can shoot for free. This also pertains to non-members. Non-members over 18 shall pay \$10.00 per match.
2. Prior to each match, there will be a quick 5-minute Safety orientation at the discretion of the designated Range Officer. Attendance at this session, if held, is mandatory for all match shooters. The purpose of the meeting is to ensure full understanding of all club safety procedures. Shooters that arrive late to the day's match and do not attend this session cannot shoot the first target until they review the safety procedures. The late shooter may then elect to start shooting on the 2nd target (Group) or set of targets (Score/Groundhog), whichever is applicable to the match of the day.
3. Note that the range will be open after the matches.

Group Match Rules – 2026 Season

1. Heavy Varmint: Total rifle weight not to exceed 13.5 lbs with sights. Any scope power and caliber is OK except for 50 cal BMG. There will be time to reload and clean between targets. Targets will be standard NBRSA/IBS group targets for both 100 and 200 yards.
2. You must fire at least 5 regular distance matches and 3 alternate distance matches to qualify for season average and/or aggregate trophies (5 matches at 200 yards, 3 matches at 100 yards). Awards will be given for smallest group at both 100 and 200 yards, as well as best single agg at 100 and 200 yards.

Score Match Rules – 2026 Season

General: Due to the fact that Orrville Printing has gotten out of the target printing business, the Club needs to switch to targets that we can obtain. As a result, the Club will be using either NBRSA/IBS score targets, or UBR targets for 2026.

Score Match Rules: All targets are shot for score. Both the 100 yard and 200 yard targets have (5) record bulls, and (1) sighter bull. The UBR target has multiple sighter bulls. These matches cannot use wind flags or mirage boards. All classes will shoot together. All rifles shall comply with current range rules. There will only be 2 classes of rifle in the Score matches, namely Factory Class and Unlimited Class.

Factory Class: Any production rifle in its original stock, with original barrel and action. Any caliber within range rules is legal. Any power scope or iron sights are permitted. No flat bottom benchrest-style stocks are allowed. Aftermarket triggers may be installed. Rifles that DO NOT qualify as Factory Class are: Remington 40X, Cooper, Kimber, and other limited production, semi-custom rifles.

Unlimited Class: This class accepts all rifles including benchrest rifles, F-class, long range bolt “Precision Rifle Series” (PRS) rifles, etc. These rifles must be fired in single shot mode, like all other classes. There are no weight restrictions. All AR-15 and AR-10 platform semi-auto rifles shall utilize a sled-type single shot adapter, and must include an attached empty shell catching net. Semi-auto rifles shall use an “Empty Chamber Indicator” (ECI) installed into the action during all range safe timeframes. The only accepted end of barrel attachment shall be a legal noise suppressor. Threaded barrels shall not have attached flash suppressors or stabilizers. All calibers are acceptable except for 50 cal. BMG. Any power scope is permitted.

Awards: There will be (2) matches at 100 yards, and (2) matches at 200 yards. Year end scoring will be the best 3 out of 4 match scores added together. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for both Factory and Unlimited
